The purpose of this MOU is to describe the intended DMI fire suppression and stand by support as it relates to Dozer Boss requirements for the Peace Management Area for the 2010 Fire Season.


Terms and Conditions:

- DMI will provide trained individuals to fill the capacity of a Dozer Boss for the 2010 Fire Season dependant on workloads and availability. These duties may be fulfilled during weekdays on an on-call basis at the Forest Resources office at the DMI complex subject to the following conditions:
 - Dozer Boss will be on-site at the specific staging area for daily safety briefings and inspection of equipment to determine functionality prior to returning to DMI.
 - Dozer Boss will remain in communication with the Duty Officer at all times (landline and/or cell phone).
 - Dozer Boss will return to staging area after office hours (1630 hrs) and remain on site until stand down time is communicated, and sign off all associated time card slips from equipment and/or drivers.
- Active Fire Duties may be restricted to fires within FMA 0900044 and FMA 0900045 and depending on individual workloads, may be restricted to weekends only. (Further duty may be subjected to Forest Resources Business Unit Leader Approval).
