**EXEMPTIONS**

Exemption from the requirements referred to in Part 5 (Means of Containment) except 5.1(3) (means of containment must withstand normal conditions of transport) of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations as adopted by the Dangerous Goods Transportation and Handling Regulations for the handling, offering for transport and transporting by road vehicle, of dangerous goods that are Classes 2.1, 2.2, 3, 6.1, 8 and 9 in a large means of containment.

**CONDITIONS**

1. The means of containment are not intended for the transportation of dangerous goods and the presence of dangerous goods is due only to the use of the means of containment for the processing, storage or use of the dangerous goods at fixed locations.

This does not include equipment used to heat and circulate production fluids, including petroleum crude oil, in oilfield applications.

2. Where the means of containment are not easily cleaned or purged, on site, the vessels must be drained of all dangerous goods to the maximum extent that is possible and shall not contain more than 5% volumetric capacity of dangerous goods, when in transportation.

3. The means of containment are designed, constructed, secured and maintained so that under normal conditions of transport there will be no release of the dangerous goods.
4. A copy of this permit shall accompany each load and the driver shall be made aware of the permit location.
5. Subject to Condition 6, all shipments must be classified in accordance with Part 2 (Classification) of the Regulations and all large means of containment must display the safety marks required in Part 4 (Safety Marks) of the Regulations and the shipment must be accompanied by a shipping document as required by Part 3 (Documentation) of the Regulations.
6. In the case of oilfield production equipment where the classification of the residue dangerous goods is unknown, the following classification may be used:

FLAMMABLE LIQUID, CORROSIVE, N.O.S. (MIXED OILFIELD PRODUCTION FLUIDS), CLASS 3 (8), UN 2924, Packing Group III.

7. This permit exempts the permit holder from only those Part(s) or Section(s) of the Regulations identified above. To qualify for the exemptions shown all permit conditions must be adhered to, and all remaining applicable provisions of the Act and Regulations, and other related legislation must be complied with.
8. If all conditions of this permit are not completely complied with, the permit holder shall totally comply with the Act and Regulations, and the permit shall no longer be applicable.
9. This permit is valid only in Alberta.
10. All those involved with the handling, offering for transport, and transporting the dangerous goods shall be trained and certified in accordance with Part 6 (Training) of the Regulations.
