RE: DMI DTLP530001 ANNUAL OPERATING PLAN

Sustainable Resource Development staff have reviewed Daishowa-Marubeni Peace River Pulp Division's (DMI) Annual Operating Plan for DTLP530001 dated June 4, 2009 and resubmitted July 9, 2009. *This approval letter replaces the previous Approval Letter dated July 16, 2009.* The plan approval is granted subject to the following conditions:

- 1/ All harvest operations (both deciduous and coniferous) are subject to the 'Manning Diversified Forest Products Ltd. Operating Ground Rules' dated February 2009.
- 2/ Retention is subject to the protocols spelled out in the joint 'DMI/CANFOR General Development Plan for 2009-2014'.
- 3/ A pre-operational start-up meeting will be required with the Forester and/or Forest Officer responsible for the area before operations will begin.
- 4/ The detours required to access Block 201 as noted in the July 9, 2009 Amendment request is approved.
- 5/ DMI shall conduct their operations in accordance with the *Alberta Forests Act, Public Lands Act, Timber Management Regulation, Forest and Prairie Protection Act, Water Act, Environmental Protection & Enhancement Act, Weed Control Act, Forest Soils Conservation Guidelines*, and all



other applicable statutes and regulations.

- 6/ All licences, authorizations and approvals issued by Alberta Sustainable Resource Development and Alberta Environment under the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* and *Water Act* should not be taken to mean DMI (applicant) has complied with federal legislation. DMI should contact Habitat Management, Fisheries and Oceans in Peace River in relation to the application of federal laws, including but not limited to the *Navigable Water Protection Act* and the *Fisheries Act (Canada)*.

Be advised that approval of DMI's DTLP530001 **Annual Operating Plan 2009-2010** does not transfer the accountability for the plan or its implementation from the DMI or the submitting Registered Forestry Professional (RFP) to SRD or its staff.
