**RE: AMENDMENT TO DMI EAST PEACE – WHISKEY JACK ANNUAL OPERATING PLAN**

Sustainable Resource Development staff have reviewed Daishowa-Marubeni Peace River Pulp Division's (DMI) AMENDMENT to the Annual Operating Plan for EAST PEACE – WHISKEY JACK (as submitted by Peggy Pike and dated September 23, 2009) to move blocks 207, 208, 209, 210, 211, 233, 237 and 238 from harvest under frozen ground conditions to harvest under non-frozen ground conditions. The amendment *approval is granted* subject to the following conditions:

- 1/ Reclamation for these blocks will follow the procedures for 'non-frozen ground operations' as noted in the 'East Peace-Whiskey Jack' Final Harvest Plan.
- 2/ An updated version of 'Table 1' for both the Final Harvest and the Annual Operating Plan will be provided to SRD by October 13, 2009.
- 3/ All conditions of Approval for the Final Harvest Plan and the Annual Operating Plan are applicable.



- 4/ Approval for cutblock harvest is subject to the submission of acceptable PHAs as described and submitted to SRD. When the PHAs that are submitted are deemed acceptable, the opening of individual cutblocks will require separate approval from SRD, in the form of a letter or a TFA.
- 5/ Approval for harvest is contingent on DMI providing information that shows that access into the now approved blocks is acceptable for use in non-frozen conditions.

Be advised that approval of this Amendment does not transfer the accountability for the plan or its implementation from the DMI or the submitting Registered Forestry Professional (RFP) to SRD or its staff.
