Sustainable Resource Development staff have reviewed Daishowa-Marubeni Peace River Pulp Division's (DMI) **Final Harvest Plan for EAST PEACE – WHISKEY JACK** dated May 28, 2009 and submitted June 5, 2009. The plan *approval is granted* subject to the following conditions:


- 1/ All operations are subject to the 'Manning Diversified Forest Products Ltd. Operating Ground Rules' dated February 2009.
- 2/ Retention standards are subject to the protocols noted in the DMI/CANFOR GDP for 2009.
- 3/ Approval for this FHP is granted, pending sign-off from any imbedded timber operators/timber disposition holders that are in the FMU.
- 4/ Approval for this FHP is granted, pending resolution to the 'regeneration of conifer areas' in a manner that is satisfactory to SRD, before the submission of the 2010 Silviculture Plan.
- 5/ An updated digital map of the FHP area is to be supplied to SRD by August 26, 2009.
- 6/ Approval for this FHP is granted, pending an access management strategy (for the Whiskey Jack Gate located on the DMI East Haul Road) that is satisfactory to SRD.



Be advised that approval of DMI's EAST PEACE – WHISKEY JACK Final Harvest Plan 2009-2010 does not transfer the accountability for the plan or its implementation from the DMI or the submitting Registered Forestry Professional (RFP) to SRD or its staff.
