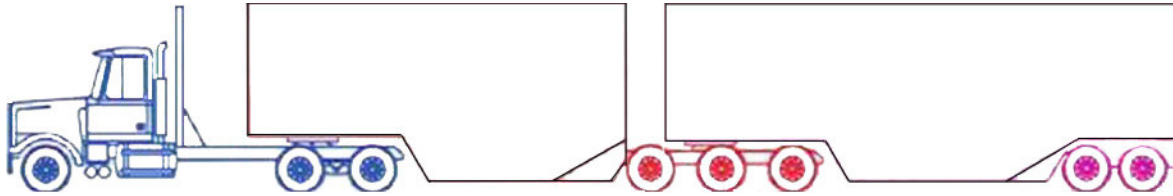

If a permit has been issued pursuant to the Traffic Safety Act authorizing the movement of wood chips and residual wood products, any and all of the following conditions shall apply in addition to any other conditions specified on the permit.

The winter weights allowed by this permit apply only to an 8 Axle B-Train chip trucks as depicted in the following image:



### Log Haul Route Map

1. This permit applies only to 8 axle B-Train transporting wood chips and residual wood products.
2. A validated map showing the destination mills for '8 Axle B-Train Chip Truck' must be used in conjunction with this permit for the noted winter weights and/or dimensions to apply.
3. During periods other than the winter weight period, this permit allows legal weights only, as per the Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulation (AR 315/2002), subject to road bans and restricted bridges. A validated route map must be used in conjunction with this permit.
4. If a map is not used in conjunction with this permit, legal weights apply.

### Dimensions

1. This permit allows increased dimensions as indicated for:
  - a. the height of the load ..... [ maximum of 4.80 metres ]
2. The Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulation (AR 315/2002) apply to all other dimensions.
3. The Cargo Securement Regulation and National Safety Code (NSC) Standard 10 apply at all times.
4. Load must consist entirely of unsettled wood chips or residual wood products.
5. Any portion of the vehicle above 4.15 meters must be a soft body, (e.g. tarp)
6. The driver must inspect the load within 40 km of origin and make any necessary adjustments to the load or tarp, to ensure load continues to be secured as required.
7. During non winter weight periods a map is not required for the increased dimensions to apply.

### Winter Weight

**Green routes:** 18,500 kg/tandem axle  
26,000 kg/tridem axle  
67,500 kg GVW

**Blue routes:** 18,000 kg/tandem axle  
25,000 kg/tridem axle  
65,000 kg GVW

**Red routes:** No winter weights. Legal weights only as per Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulation, subject to road bans and restricted bridges.

**Brown routes:** Private, Bush, and Licence of Occupation Roads. Check with the owner for allowable weights.

**Black routes:** Non log haul roads. Legal weights and dimensions apply.

### NOTE:

- (a) A winter weight log haul permit, along with a validated route map is required.
- (b) Winter weights apply only during frozen road conditions as directed in writing to the mill by Alberta Transportation.
- (c) The steering axle weight shall not exceed:
  - 5,500 kg
- (d) The weights indicated include all tolerance. No further tolerance will be allowed.

### Rated Capacity of Equipment

In compliance with Section 12 of the Occupational Health and Safety Code 2009, a written Acceptance granted by a Director of Inspection under Section 10 of the *Occupational Health and Safety Regulation* and Section 34 of the *Occupational Health and Safety Act* will take precedence over Schedule 7 (c) of the *Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulation AR315/2002*.
