## FIBRELINE OPERATING TECHNICIAN:

**An opportunity exists for a motivated, positive individual to join our Fibreline Department at Daishowa-Marubeni International, Peace River Pulp Division as a Fibreline Operating Technician.**

PRPD Fibreline Operators are instrumental in our pulp-making process by ensuring that the wood chips are transferred from chip piles into our digester where they are cooked under pressure through the use of liquor and heat to extract the lignin from the chips. Fibreline Operators have the responsibility to make sure area and process systems function properly. They consider personnel safety as the primary objective and ensure production processes are operating safely. They continually monitor instrumentation and the operation of equipment and make adjustments to keep system process variables within acceptable ranges. As well, they also detect potential and actual problems and take corrective action to prevent the interruption of system operations.

A fully competent operator at PRPD will be able to:

- Operate PRPD's pulp mill in a safe and effective manner
- Monitor instrumentation and the operation of equipment
- Make adjustments to keep system process variables, such as flows, temperatures, and pressures, within acceptable ranges
- Detect potential and actual problems and take corrective action to prevent the interruption of system operations
- Analyze operational trends and take corrective actions
- Use standard operating procedures to start and stop production equipment
- Maintain communication with other operators, maintenance, and management

Our Fibreline Operating Technician positions involve working on a revolving 28-day work cycle, working 14 days a month (a combination of 7 nights and 7 days, not in succession). Our Technician system is based on pay-for-skills, with higher compensation at every level of competency.

### QUALIFICATIONS:

We are looking for an individual with a positive attitude and who can demonstrate the following behaviours:

- Self Starter – You are a highly motivated person who gets the job done while working in a team environment. You are self directed and demonstrate good time management and problem solving skills.
