The equipment in our Power and Recovery area includes a Black Liquor Fired Recovery Boiler with a steaming rate of 305 tons per hour; hog (bark) fired Power Boiler with a steaming rate of 135 tons per hour; 44 MW steam turbine; Black liquor evaporators; Lime Kiln; and Raw Water and Waste Water treatment plants. A fully competent operator at PRPD will be able to:
