# Preventative Maintenance Technician (Lubrication)

The Peace River Pulp Division is looking to fill the position of a Lubrication-Preventative Maintenance Technician within the Mill's Maintenance Department. This position will report directly to the Maintenance Reliability Lead and will be responsible for maintaining, repairing and troubleshooting industrial machinery and mechanical equipment, specific to lubrication.

### Role and Responsibilities

- Perform lubrication and monitoring duties following Industry standard best practices to ensure proper function and longevity of equipment reliability.
- Provide technical recommendations for any equipment issues and advise on necessary upgrades to machines in order to extend equipment life and increase reliability and/or efficiency.
- Be familiar and understand equipment diagrams, schematic drawings, electronic monitoring route tracking devices and service manuals to determine work procedures and best practices for the lubrication of equipment.
- Assist Maintenance Technicians in equipment maintenance repairs when required during Area/Major outages.
- Manage the lubrication shop's lube, oil and grease inventory and ensure an organized and efficient working environment.
- Continuously monitor and communicate findings related to equipment oil sampling analysis program.
- Ensure all maintenance generated documentation conforms to PRPD policy and procedures .
- Communicate with maintenance trades, production leads/operators regarding mechanical problems and opportunity for improvements of efficiency and safety.
- Ensure that all work is completed safely, to schedule and cost effectively.
- Additional duties as required.

### Qualifications and Experience

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Strong mechanical abilities and problem solving skills.
- Exposure to a Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS).
- Hard working, self-directed, team-oriented individual.
- Strong communication skills both verbal and written.
